

FoodChange's Privacy Policy

FoodChange understands your concerns about privacy, in general, and Internet privacy, in particular, and takes these matters very seriously. FoodChange is committed to protecting the privacy of all people sharing personal information with us, especially our Web site visitors.

Permission:

Online giving to us is strictly permission-based: You control the use of your name, your personal information, and your donation. When you donate to FoodChange, we collect only the information about you that is needed to process your donation, such as your name, address, credit card number, plus information about your current donation, such as amount, program, and dedication.

Confidentiality:

FoodChange does not sell, rent, or exchange the e-mail addresses, mail addresses, or names of our donors and e-subscribers. It is our policy never to disclose any personal information to an outside entity without your explicit permission. However, if you give us your e-mail address and/or postal address, we reserve the right to send you periodic mailings and/or e-mails with information on our programs, services, or information on upcoming events.

Technology:

FoodChange uses Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) online technology, which encrypts the data you submit. This technology ensures that sensitive information, such as your credit card number, becomes unreadable to anyone who attempts to intercept the information. SSL is supported by all major Web browsers, including Microsoft Internet Explorer and Netscape Navigator. The site becomes locked while you are giving us your credit card information and unlocks only when you leave the secured area.

Anonymity:

In our communications and promotional initiatives, FoodChange may at times list the names of individual benefactors. If you want your support to remain anonymous and kept from publication, please indicate so at the time of your donation.
